NOTICE

The Graduate Program Coordination Committee in Urology of the Faculty of Medicine of the University of São Paulo announces that it will be accepting applications for the selection of candidates for **15 (fifteen) positions** in the Master's/Doctoral program, as described below:

I. ENROLLMENT

Enrollments must be completed at the program's secretariat, located at Av. Dr. Enéas de Carvalho Aguiar, 255 - 7th floor - room 7123, from **January 15th, 2025 to June 30th, 2025**, on weekdays, from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

II. CONDITIONS FOR ENROLLMENT

1. Graduate Student Enrollment Form (www.fm.usp.br - graduate programs - strictu sensu - enrollment)
2. Legible copy of the National Registry (identity card); for foreign students: legible copy of the National Migration Registry (RNM)
3. Legible copy of the Individual Taxpayer Registry (CPF)
4. 1 recent photo 3 X 4
5. Legible copy of the Graduation Diploma, with MEC registration (front and back). In the absence of a diploma, a recent declaration from the originating institution must be presented, indicating the date on which the graduation ceremony took place.
6. English Proficiency Test result (valid for 5 years), Email: pinheiros@culturainglesasp.com.br - Phone: 3032-4888. Foreign students are required to present a certificate of intermediate level in the Portuguese proficiency test, conducted by CELPE-Brás, up to 18 months for the Master's program and 24 months for the Doctoral and Direct Doctoral programs, starting from the beginning of the program (<http://portal.mec.gov.br/sesu>)
7. Proof of payment of the enrollment fee of R\$ 259.14 (two hundred and fifty-nine reais and fourteen cents).

Note: The following English proficiency tests are also accepted: Reading Test in English for Candidates for Postgraduate Courses, held by Cultura Inglesa, exclusively for the Faculty of Medicine of USP. Minimum score for the Master's program: 50 points; for the Doctoral program: 60 points; Alumni: www.alumni.org.br/ with the following score: B1 (CEF) for the Master's program and B1+ (CEF) for the Doctoral program; Tese Prime: www.teseprime.org/apresentacao.php (TEAP) with the following score: 60% of the score for the Master's program and 70% for the Doctoral program. TOEFL Internet-based Test, with a minimum score of 40 points for the Master's program and 61 points for the Doctoral program; TOEFL Computer-based Test, with a minimum score of 120 points for the Master's program and 173 points for the Doctoral program; TOEFL Paper-based Test, with a minimum score of 433 points for the Master's program and 500 points for the Doctoral program; TOEFL Institutional is not accepted.



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III. SELECTION

1. To enroll, the candidate must submit the following to the CCP:

- research project approved by the institution's Ethics Committee.
- two letters of recommendation attesting to the candidate's scientific, moral, and intellectual suitability, as well as their responsibility in fulfilling commitments.
- evidence of future perspectives for involvement with teaching and research after completion of graduate studies.

2. Selection Criteria:

Criteria for the Master's Degree (ME)

Candidates who score 7 or above will be considered for admission to the program, subject to the availability of an advisor. The score will be based on the following criteria:

- a. Research Project: Score from 0 to 10 (weight 6)
- b. Evaluation of the candidate's Curriculum Lattes: Score from 0 to 10 (weight 4)
The following items will be considered in the Curriculum Lattes evaluation: training (weight 2), prior research experience (weight 3), publications (weight 5).

3. Criteria for the Doctoral program with Master's degree (DO)

Candidates who score 7 or above will be considered for admission to the program, subject to the availability of an advisor. The score will be based on the following criteria:

- a. Research Project: Score from 0 to 10 (weight 6).
- b. Evaluation of the candidate's Curriculum Lattes: Score from 0 to 10 (weight 4)
The following items will be considered in the Curriculum Lattes evaluation: training (weight 2), prior research experience (weight 3), publications (weight 5).

4. Criteria for the Direct Doctoral program (DD)

For enrollment in the selection process for the Doctoral program without prior acquisition of a Master's degree (Direct Doctorate), candidates must provide proof of:



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- Scientific initiation with publication of an article as first author or co-author in a journal indexed in ISI, or;
- Prior research involvement with at least 1 article accepted for publication as author or co-author in a journal indexed in ISI with an impact factor equal to or above 0.5, or;
- Candidates with exceptional qualifications, demonstrated through activities and completed work, scientific recognition evidenced by lectures, a specialist title in urology, presentations at congresses and participation in editorial boards of scientific journals, may enroll in the Direct Doctoral program according to the criteria detailed below.

Candidates who score 7 or above will be considered for admission to the program, subject to the availability of an advisor. The score will be based on the following criteria:

- a. Research Project: Score from 0 to 10 (weight 6).
- b. Evaluation of the candidate's Curriculum Lattes: Score from 0 to 10 (weight 4). The following items will be considered in the Curriculum Lattes evaluation: training (weight 2), prior research experience (weight 3), publications (weight 5).

IV. RESULTS

The results of the selection process will be announced by the Graduate Program in Urology (Tel. (11) 2661-8086).

V. ENROLLMENT

Enrolment of selected candidates must be done at the same location as the application, Av. Dr. Enéas de Carvalho Aguiar, 255 - 7th floor - room 7123.
